Day by Day Guide for Praying through the New Testament in One Year

As you read each day's passage from the New Testament, spend a few minutes in prayer inspired by the passage and the thoughts below.

Monday, March 2 – Mark 10:32-52 – Do you trust God to promote you in life or are you doing everything to create your own opportunities? How is that working for you? Seek to apply today's thoughts from Jesus to your own life opportunities.

Tuesday, March 3 – Mark 11:1-25 – Do you have faith that God has your best interests in mind? Do your actions in life prove that? Spend time listing the things that you just don't have faith that God will take care of in your life. Give those to God in faith.

Wednesday, March 4 – Mark 11:27-12:17 – After reading this passage, sit back in solitude and quiet for 10 minutes. Rest in God's peace before you act in any way today.

Thursday, March 5 – Mark 12:18-34 – The things about God that we have the toughest time with are those things we just don't understand like Jesus' thoughts on relationships and life after death. List those scary things and ask God to give you the faith to trust Him to have your best interest and best future in mind.

Friday, March 6 – Mark 12:35-13:13 – Just as the widow gave generously out of what she did not have and trusted God to take care of her, commit your finances to God. Commit to give first and pay second, trusting God for the provision. Then watch!

Saturday, March 7 – Mark 13:14-37 – It's a scary thing to think about how things will end in this world, whether by death or by Jesus returning to take His people home. Once again, an opportunity has arisen to trust God to take care of your future. Give it to Him.

Sunday, March 8 – Mark 14:1-26 – Journal what you gave to God to fix, forgive, handle, and miraculously heal. List what you heard from Him this week.
