Day by Day Guide for Praying through the New Testament in One Year

As you read each day's passage from the New Testament, spend a few minutes in prayer inspired by the passage and the thoughts below.

Monday, March 23 – Luke 5:29-6:11 – Jesus had tough words for the religious community, because they thought they were all right in life with no problems like everyone else. Spend some time seeking how God might want you to recognize your need of a physician and the humble spirit to love everyone right where they are.

Tuesday, March 24 – Luke 6:12-38 – Think of those who have or are hurting you and take Jesus' advice and spend some time this morning praying for them. Ask Him if He would have you bless them, and then obey whatever fleeting thought comes into your mind.

Wednesday, March 25 – Luke 6:39-7:10 – Jesus is still wanting us to think more about our own challenges than point out those of others. What are your speck and log issues in life. Write them out below and ask Him to help you get the log out of your own eye.

Thursday, March 26 – Luke 7:11-35 – Do you need to be entertained to enjoy life? Jesus got criticized for this. The fickle crowd will never be pleased. Ask God to help you **KNOW** what is right and to have the courage to live it no matter what anyone thinks.

Friday, March 27 – Luke 7:36-8:3 – Like the woman with the perfume, do something outrageous in worship of God today. Write it out below, along with a prayer of thanks and worship to God.

Saturday, March 28 – Luke 8:4-21 – Which seed are you from Jesus' story? Ask Him to plant you in the fertile ground and to germinate your heart for Him no matter your circumstances. Ask Him to give you the faith to believe in Him and His plan for you.

Sunday, March 29 – Luke 8:22-39 – Journal in the space below what you gave to God to fix, forgive, handle, and miraculously heal. List out what you heard from Him this week.
