

# A Day By Day Guide

## Day by Day Guide for Praying through the New Testament in One Year

As you read each day's passage from the New Testament, spend a few minutes in prayer inspired by the passage and the thoughts below.

**Monday, March 30** – Luke 8:40-9:6 – What, like Jairus in this passage, do you need to keep having faith in God to accomplish in your life? Does it seem like no answer is coming or that it is too late? Pray one more time in faith, believing that God will give you the answer, then wait and obey.

**Tuesday, March 31** – Luke 9:7-27 – What is the cross that you have to bear for Jesus? Have you ever thought about that? It may be your family, your job, your health, your contentment. Write out what you think it is, then ask God to teach you through it today and bring you joy because of it.

**Wednesday, April 1** – Luke 9:28-50 – Compare the disciples arguing about the greatest among them with Jesus telling them they had to be like a child to know Him. What is the comparison – isn't it utter dependence on someone? Are you depending fully on God to live your life or are you trying to help Him make you great? Talk to Him about it!

**Thursday, April 2** – Luke 9:51 – 10:12 – What is it that keeps you from following after God with all your heart? Job? Family? Partying? Getting yourself worthy? Stop worrying about that and just come to Him in utter dependence. Leave the other stuff to Him! Ask Him right now to guide you to faith in Him and to go wherever **He** leads.

**Friday, April 3** – Luke 10:13-37 – Ask God to give you a “Good Samaritan” day and then depend on Him to lead you to that opportunity. Write about it below and thank Him.

**Saturday, April 4** – Luke 10:38-11:13 – Thank God for the equality in ministry that Jesus places on men and women as illustrated here. Ask God to show you your purpose and your ministry that He has for you today.

**Sunday, March 29** – Luke 8:22-39 – Journal in the space below what you gave to God to fix, forgive, handle, and miraculously heal. List out what you heard from Him this week.
