Imagine Me Without U

- Monday** Ask God to show you ways to strategize for **A.R.K.** (**A**cts of **R**andom **K**indness). Write down the thoughts that come to your mind, commit them to God and ask Him to open up obvious opportunities for you today and for the month of December. Worship Him by looking for doors of serving possibilities through **A.R.K.**
- Tuesday** Imagine Christmas being a time of joy and a delight! What will that take for you? Too tall a task? Let's concentrate then on some attitude shifts and habit changes that might just make this a great December for you! In Philippians 2:1,2, the Bible defines what it is going to take. What in verse two can you work on this December?
- Wednesday** Can you imagine a good December yet? Philippians 2:3,4 gives you a few more clues at the attitude and thinking shift that is necessary to enjoy life. Selflessness takes a conscious effort but pays off in great dividends of peace, joy and love. Notice also that the key to joy is to lend a helping hand to others. Ask God to give you the eyes to see these opportunities today.
- Thursday** As you continue to work on a great December, look at the example of Jesus found in Philippians 2:5-9. He not only taught us how to do it, but He modeled how to do it as well. He lived what He asked us to do in verses 1-4. This is the Christmas story personified. Worship Jesus by reading this passage again as a prayer of thanks. Insert "Thank you, Jesus, for..." before each sentence of these verses.
- Friday** Today would be a good day to memorize a part of the Bible. Spend 5 minutes writing down verses 3 and 4 of Philippians 2 and try to memorize them. Worship God throughout the day by taking this passage with you and committing it to memory. Be sure to look for ways to act it out while doing so.
- Saturday** Commit an **Act of Random Kindness** on yourself today by doing some activity that you really enjoy. Celebrate God's unique creation of "You." What brings you inner joy and peace? I know, I know...you don't have the time for such foolishness! Do it anyway and dedicate that time as worship of God's creative Spirit within you! Oh! And make it an activity that absolutely costs you no money – only time! Ask God to join you in it!
