

# Dig-A-Little-Deeper

“The Ultimate Love Affair”

Look at the passages in the Bible that reveal God’s love for us. Experiment with accepting His love by faith and with what He says about His love for you. Talk to Him throughout the week about His love for you!

**Monday** Jesus talks about the protection of His love for you in John 10 and His goal for your life in John 10:10.

**Tuesday** Jesus talks about how we are to come to understand His love for us in John 3 and why God sent Jesus to Earth to love us in verses 16 and 17.

**Wednesday** In Romans 5, God tells the Roman church in Italy how much God loved us and sought us even though we wanted nothing to do with Him. He is a persistent lover, especially in verses 6-8.

**Thursday** God reveals how much He thinks of us in Romans 8 – not willing to condemn us for sin, but to forgive with endless grace. In verse 17, He reveals that when He thinks of us - He puts us on the same level as Jesus Christ – co-heirs to all He has!

**Friday** In Romans 10, God reveals the ultimate test of love – there must be a choice and a decision to enter into relationship and receive the love. Verses 10 and 11 explain how one must enter into a relationship of Love with God – it takes a decision of brain, heart, and spirit.

**Saturday** If you have not done so, choose to enter into a relationship with God by praying the following prayer:

“God, I accept the fact that you love me. I want to quit trying to make it on my own and I choose to admit that I am a sinner. Please forgive me for my sin. I accept your forgiveness and your offer of love in my life. I choose to enter into a relationship with you today and to live with you forever.”

**If you prayed this prayer, take the next steps that will lead you to grow in your relationship with God:**

1. Call another Christ Follower. Tell them about your decision.
2. Choose to identify with God and Jesus in relationship by getting baptized on Sunday, April 6. For more info, attend the Baptism Class after service (11:45) on March 30 in the Commons Area.
3. Consistently attend church and build relationships with other Christ Followers
4. Build your relationship with God by reading about in Him in the New Testament.
